Mango Languages is an interactive, online system that teaches real conversation skills for practical communication. The system is completely web-based and remotely accessible, so users can learn anywhere there is an Internet connection. Each lesson combines real life situations and audio from native speakers with simple, clear instructions.

Mango is available in two versions: *Mango Basic* and *Mango Complete*. Each *Mango Basic* lesson teaches polite speaking skills in a short period of time. It's a great way to get a taste for a language and to learn a few useful conversations. For users already familiar with the basics, *Mango Complete* lessons delve more deeply into the language and culture. The courses require 2-5 hours to complete and are currently available in 22 foreign languages and 15 English as a Second Language (ESL) courses.

There is also a segment designed specifically for ages 0-6. *Little Pim*, an animated panda, teaches kid-friendly words and phrases and memory building exercises in 10 languages.
