The goal is to preserve the history of Munising and Alger County and make it available to present and future generations in a format that is readily accessible and available.

Local matching fund partners include: Alger County Historical Society and Heritage Center, Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore, Kiwanis of Alger County, Friends of the Munising School Public Library, Grand Island Lodge No. 422 of Free and Accepted masons.

Pre-1940 Munising News microfilms were practically illegible. These were refilmed and other Alger County newspapers were filmed. Munising High School yearbooks were also filmed.
