Bobby Bullet, born Robert St. Germaine on the Lac du Flambeau Indian Reservation in 1942 is a gentle man who walks with purpose, speaks with reverence, lives with honor and sings of life with all its grainy truth and joyful laughter. Grounded in personal experience and cultural history this singer songwriter spans generations to bring the awareness of shared connections through his music, linking past present and future.

In the complexity of his voice you will hear echoes of our shared history. The gift of candor carefully crafted to expose essential truths in a gripping and entertaining series of tales will speak to your heart. "Scrapbook" nominated in eight categories for the 2010 Native American Music Association awards was followed by his new CD "Bigfoot" which was release in October 2010.
