



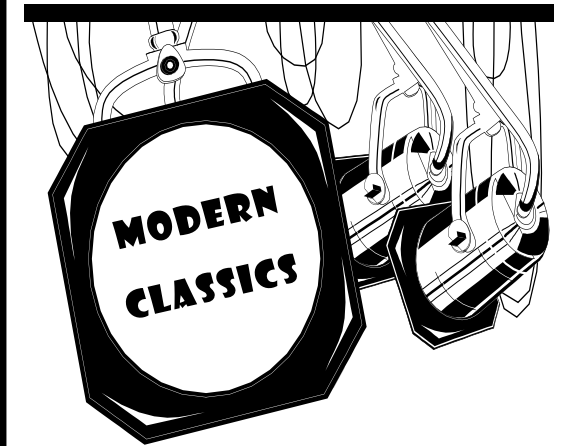

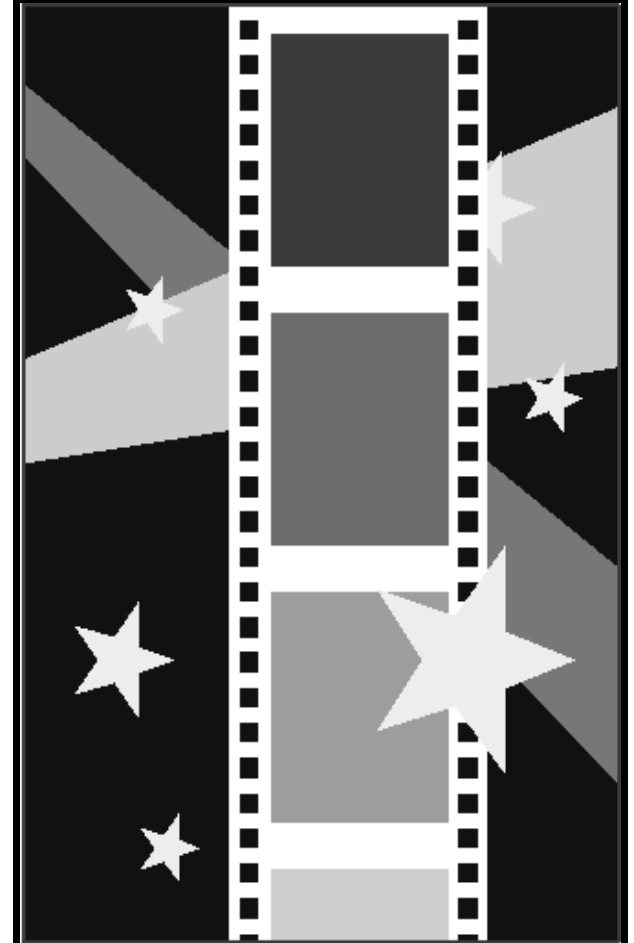
- 9/11 *The Beatles: Eight Days a Week: The Touring Years***
