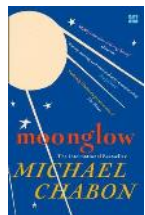
### Tues. Mar. 5: **Family Literacy Night**

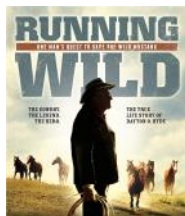


### Mon. Mar. 11: **Personal Legacy Workshop**
