1. Annual Meeting with continuing education program and vendors – also a great opportunity to network with your library colleagues. Nonmembers pay a higher registration fee.
2. Group discounts on books, AV, supplies. Find vendors & discounts on this web site <http://www.uproc.lib.mi.us/slc/slcindex.htm>. Set up your account with the discount rate prior to placing your first order.
3. Identify UP library titles in the UPRLC online regional catalog at <http://ibistro.uproc.lib.mi.us> for interlibrary loan. Most of these libraries will take paper requests for interlibrary loan.
4. Find Upper Peninsula library home pages and web sites easily by using a map at www.uplibraries.org. If you have a web page for your library, we would love to add it here. Call the number above and ask for web pages administrator.
5. Research Upper Peninsula history at a web site maintained by Superiorland Co-op and UPRLC staff at www.uphistory.org. Please check out the Bay Mills Community College collection of Native American artifacts. Those images have some of the most ‘hits’ from researchers in the collection.
